**SUMMARY OF POLICIES**

**NON-DISCRIMINATION**

Students are admitted without regard to race, color, religion, nationality, or ethnic origin.

**FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM**

Berkeley Montessori School values economic diversity in its student body. We encourage applications for tuition assistance. Requests for assistance are treated in confidence and assistance is provided on the basis of need. Median assistance is 45% of tuition. Preference is given to requests from returning students. Applications can be obtained starting in December from the Business Office at 1310 University Avenue. They should be submitted by the published deadlines.

**DEPOSIT**

A **non-refundable tuition deposit** of \$1,500 is due with a signed copy of the Enrollment Contract which has been returned to the School by the due date of the Contract. The deposit is applied against tuition. Contracts returned after the due date must also be accompanied by a non-refundable late fee of \$50 in order to be considered. The tuition deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable, even if you withdraw your child from Berkeley Montessori School prior to the start of the program for which your child has been enrolled.

**OBLIGATION FOR FULL ANNUAL TUITION**

You are liable for the full annual tuition on June 1, 2007. You may elect to pay the full annual tuition on June 1, 2007 or on deferred terms in 11 installments starting June 1, 2006, but, by signing the Enrollment Contract, you are obliged for the full amount thereof.

**DEFERRED PAYMENT OPTION**

Monthly Payment Plan: 11 monthly payments starting June 1, 2007, with no payment in February, 2008  
Deferred Payment Charge: 5% of deferred amount (net of any Tuition Assistance)

**SIBLING DISCOUNTS ARE NOT AVAILABLE**

**LATE PAYMENT**

A late fee will be assessed at \$35 per month on all balances not received on the agreed due date.

**DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS**

If a child's account during the school year has amounts unpaid for more than 60 days, the child may not be permitted to attend School. The child's return will be conditional on payment of all past due amounts, and the continued availability of a space in the classroom, which the School does not guarantee.

**WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL**

If, after June 1, 2007, you withdraw your child from Berkeley Montessori School for any reason, you shall remain liable for the full tuition for the 2007-2008 academic year. Berkeley Montessori School shall use its best efforts to fill the classroom space vacated by your child with a suitable replacement student and will refund to you a proportionate amount of the tuition, less the tuition deposit, in the event this occurs. If during the academic year, a child is withdrawn from enrollment at the request of Berkeley Montessori School, the tuition due will be calculated on a pro rata basis and any amounts so calculated will be immediately due.

**PARENT PARTICIPATION EXPECTATION**

Families are expected to participate actively in the life of the School in two ways:  
1) Contribute to the Annual Fund at a personally significant level; and  
2) Perform at least 20 hours of volunteer service each school year ending June 30.
